After settling with his family into their Tuscan estate at Tenuta San Guido, he experimented with several French grape varieties and concluded, "the bouquet I was looking for" was found in the Cabernet which represented a radical shift from the traditional Tuscan varietals of Sangiovese and Nebbiolo. The 1968 vintage of **Sassicaia** was the first to be offered on the open market and it was as well received as the Premier Crûs from Bordeaux.*

***Château Musar** is located in an 18th Century castle in Ghazir, just fifteen miles north of Beirut, in the fertile Bekaa Valley of Lebanon. Their grand vin is the red **Château Musar**, a blend which may include Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsaut, Carignan, Grenache and Mourvedre. The wine is fermented in concrete, before spending one year in vat, then a year in French oak, before going back to vat for several years. Serge Hochar, owner/winemaker believes his wine needs years - perhaps ten - before it is ready for drinking, and the wines are already some way towards that age when they are finally released onto the market.*

***Seña** is the result of the union of winemaking families from both North and South America. These families are headed by Eduardo Chadwick, of Viña Errazuriz, and Robert Mondavi. **Seña** is produced at the Don Maximiano Estate in the Aconcagua Valley, which has long been a source of premium grapes for Viña Errazuriz. The Aconcagua Valley was chosen as the source for all of Sena's fruit because of its ideal viticultural climate, with wet winters but a long, dry growing season. It is a blend of classic Bordeaux varieties including Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Carmenère, this latter grape being widespread in Chile, having once been mistaken for Merlot.*
